

Archery NZ Criteria for FISU 2012 World University Archery Championships Policy



The qualifying criteria for the FISU 2012 World University Archery Championships being held in Córdoba, Spain in July 2012 have been outlined below. Archers seeking selection must belong to one of Archery New Zealand's three squads, being: the High Performance Squad, the Senior Development Squad, or the Junior Development Squad.

Other eligibility as defined by the organisers:

Furthermore, archers must be born between 1st January 1984 and 31st December 1994, and also must be "student athletes that have not been out of university or its equivalent for more than a year and that are between 17 and 28 years old".

Three scores are required to have been shot during the qualifying period at no less than a major tournament, domestically or internationally.

The criteria are as follows:

Scores (only to be shot at 90m and 70m for the FITA rounds):

Women	Recurve	1250 (70m)	615 (70m)
	Compound	1350 (70m)	660 (50m)
Men	Recurve	1250 (90m)	625 (70m)

Qualifying period:

1st March 2011 to 30th April 2012

Achieving the above scores in the required qualifying period does not mean automatic selection to the FISU 2012 World University Archery Championships. There may be the requirement to compete in a trial event for selection to the FISU 2012 World University Archery Championships. The venue for trials will be at the discretion of the Archery NZ Selection Panel. Failure to compete in required trials will automatically exclude you from selection for said event.
