

# Archery NZ Criteria for FITA 2013 World Archery Youth Championships Policy



The qualifying criteria for the FITA 2013 World Archery Youth Championships being held in Wuxi, China in September 2013 have been outlined below. Archers seeking selection must belong to one of Archery New Zealand's three squads, being: the High Performance Squad, the Senior Development Squad, or the Junior Development Squad.

Three scores are required to have been shot during the qualifying period at no less than a major tournament, domestically or internationally.

## The criteria are as follows:

### Qualifying period:

**1<sup>st</sup> January 2012 to 30<sup>th</sup> April 2013**

Achieving the above scores in the required qualifying period does not mean automatic selection to the FITA 2013 World Archery Youth Championships. There may be the requirement to compete in a trial event for selection to the FITA 2013 World Archery Youth Championships. The venue for trials will be at the discretion of the Archery NZ Selection Panel. Failure to compete in required trials will automatically exclude you from selection for said event.
