

NOVICE AND DEVELOPMENT CLASS TRIAL - 2021-2022 SEASON

(22 December 2021)

As part of the goal to make Archery more inclusive to all archers in New Zealand, the Archery NZ Board has decided to trial two new classes for the 2021/22 season. These being a Novice and a Development Class. Novice archers will be those new to the sport and the Development Class is aimed at archers early in their progression of the sport.

The two classes' levels are being implemented to achieve several goals:

- Create a pathway for archers
- Allow all archers to aspire to and meet tangible targets in their archery
- Create a more level playing field for archers new or early in their development in the sport
- Assist in the development and growth of archery into a mainstream sport in New Zealand


For the first year of this trial the new classes will be held at the Outdoor and Indoor National Championships, and they will compete for medals at those events. For other competitions, the Local Organising Committee (LOC) will decide if they are to be included, though this is strongly encouraged.

The Archery NZ membership subscription for "new" members joining under the Novice or Development classes will be \$70. Please note, if new Novice/Development members wish to shoot in other age classes, they must upgrade to a full membership.

Novice / Development Classes are not intended to be introduced to the 2021/22 ANZ Inter-Club Challenge.

Rules

- 1. Archers are eligible to compete in the Novice class if they have started archery within 18 months of the end of the current membership year (30 September), with automatic progression to Development Class in the following membership year.
- 2. Progression from Development to Senior/other age classes will occur at the beginning of the next season (1st October) after the attainment of a single score equal to or higher than the identified Merit Score for the division (see below for scores).
- 3. Archers may choose to compete in 'higher' classes but not lower, e.g., Novice archers may choose to compete in the Development Class, or Senior/other age classes directly, but must upgrade to full membership to compete in the Senior/other age classes
- 4. Merit scores may be attained at registered minor or major tournaments.
- 5. Scores from previous seasons will be acknowledged. Therefore, if an archer has previously achieved a merit score in a certain discipline, they will not be eligible for that class.
- 6. Existing full members may shoot in Novice or Development classes if they meet eligibility criteria.
- 7. An archer can be eligible for different classes for different divisions (Compound, Recurve, Barebow, Longbow).
- 8. The required scores will be the same for all ages and genders within each discipline.
