

## Pacific Games 2019



### SELECTION CRITERIA

#### Introduction

The [Oceania Continental Qualifying Tournament for Mixed Team places at the Games of the XXXII Olympiad](#) will be held in during the [Pacific Games, Apia, Samoa, 7<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2019](#).

This Policy sets out how Archery NZ will consider Athletes for Selection to compete at the Pacific Games & Oceania Continental Qualifying Tournament (CQT).

The principal aims of selection for this Event is to gain New Zealand representation at the Pacific Games & CQT. Hereby known as the "Games".

The Archery Event at the Games consists of Men's and Women's Recurve 70m Qualification Round & Mixed Team Elimination Match Play ("Archery Event").

The number of Athletes Archery NZ may nominate in the Archery Event is:

- Recurve – Women (3)
- Recurve – Men (3)

## Selection Criteria

### 1. Application of this Selection Criteria

- 1.1 This Selection Criteria is issued by the Board of Archery NZ.
- 1.2 This Selection Criteria shall take effect from **1<sup>st</sup> October 2018**.
- 1.3 This Selection Criteria applies to all Athletes wishing to be considered for Selection to the Pacific Games 2019.

### 2. Selectors

- 2.1 **Composition:** The Selectors have been appointed by the Executive of Archery NZ. The Selectors who will consider Selection of Athletes to the Pacific Games Team are:
  - Karen Moffatt-McLeod, Convener
  - Patrick Biggs
  - Rynard Van Tonder

### 3. Selection Procedure

- 3.1 **Conditions of Selection:** The Selectors may only consider an Athlete for Selection if the Athlete has satisfied the following conditions of Selection:
  - (a) returned a completed Athlete Application to the NZOC, in the form prescribed by the NZOC to the following dates ("Application Date") **no later than 5.00pm Monday 7th January 2018**; and
  - (b) returned a completed Athlete Agreement to the NZOC, in the form prescribed by the NZOC prior to 7<sup>th</sup> May 2019; and
  - (c) demonstrated to the satisfaction of Archery NZ that they are not suffering any physical or mental impairment that would prevent them from competing in the Games to the highest possible standard; and
  - (d) acted in such a manner so as not to bring the Athlete, the sport, Archery NZ or the NZOC into public disrepute; and
  - (e) to Archery NZ's knowledge has not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the Athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in the Archery NZ's, World Archery's or NZOC's Integrity Regulation; and
  - (f) met the following Archery NZ minimum qualification score (MQS) on at least 2 occasions, one of which must be at a Major domestic or International tournament /or key event (4.2), and a maximum of one MQS can be shot at a registered minor

tournament (RMT) for a 72 arrow between 12<sup>th</sup> January 2018 and 11th January 2019 and provide evidence of such scores to Archery NZ:

- **Men 70m round: 550**
- **Women 70m round: 520;** and

- (g) be a current and full financial member of Archery NZ and not have any outstanding liabilities to Archery NZ; and
- (h) be a New Zealand Citizen and hold a valid passport which at the date of the event has at least 6 months before expiry is due; and
- (i) complete an "Intention to Apply" form (appendix A), to be received by Archery NZ no later than 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2018; and
- (j) not be under investigation for any breach of, nor to have breached, any rule under the Archery NZ Constitution, the Archery NZ Regulations, or any rules or regulations of World Archery, the IOC or the NZOC; and
- (k) no later than 7 January 2019 (or such extended dates as agreed by the NZOC Board) has provided their name and contact address details to NZOC for the purpose of out of competition drug testing with Drug Free Sport New Zealand.

3.2 **Qualification:** New Zealand must qualify for places in an Archery Event(s) in accordance with World Archery's Qualification System and/or World Archery's requirements for the Games. Qualification for a place in any Archery Event(s) by an Athlete does not guarantee that Athlete will be nominated or selected to compete in the Archery Event(s) at the Games of the XXXII Olympiad Tokyo, Japan 24<sup>th</sup> July – August 9<sup>th</sup> 2020.

3.3 **Selection if Selection Criteria Met:** Provided the requirements set out in clause 3.1 and 3.2 are met, the Selectors shall nominate those Athletes it considers meet the Selection Criteria set out below.

## 4. Selection Criteria

4.1 **Selection Criteria:** The Archery NZ Selection Criteria for Selection to the Pacific Games Team is made up of two parts:

- (a) the Over-Riding Selection Criteria specified in clause 4.2; and
- (b) the Specific Selection Factors specified in clause 4.3.

4.2 **Over-Riding Selection Criteria:**

- (a) In determining whether or not to nominate an Athlete to an Archery Event, the Selectors must be satisfied overall that the Athlete:
  - i. has a track record of sufficient quality and depth that Archery NZ believes demonstrates the Athlete will be competitive at the Games and will perform creditably in the Archery Event.
- (b) In determining whether or not the Athlete has met the Over-Riding Selection Criteria for Archery Events in clause 4.2(a) above, the Selectors shall consider the Athlete's performances and results in the Archery Event at which they seek to be selected for the Games in the following Key Events:

### Archery NZ Selection Event 2019

*\*Athletes must compete in both of the above events*

*\*\*If the Archer is unable attend one of the above listed events, he/she must submit an Archery NZ Dispensation Form prior to the Archery NZ National Championships for approval by both the Selectors and the Board of Archery NZ, in their sole discretion.*

4.3 **Specific Selection Factors:** When considering the Over-Riding Selection Criteria above, the Selectors may also take into account any one or more of the following factors about an Athlete:

- (a) any other performances or results in competitions / events in addition to the Key Events;
- (b) adequate fitness and a commitment to maintain a fitness and training programme as agreed with the applicable coach(es);
- (c) demonstrated good behavior, including a commitment to training and attendance at training camps;
- (d) demonstrated compatibility with others in a team environment;
- (e) demonstrated compliance with the rules of events and competitions;
- (f) understanding and respect for the obligations that accompany being a member of a New Zealand team when competing at the Games, including respect for team members and support staff;
- (g) willingness to promote Archery NZ in a positive manner;
- (h) demonstrated ability to take personal responsibility for self and their results;
- (i) proven ability to be reliable; and
- (j) any other factor(s) the Selectors consider relevant.

4.4 **Own Enquiries:** In considering any one or more of the above factors, the Selectors may make such enquiries of the Athlete, or other persons, as they see fit.

4.5 **Weight to be Given to Specific Selection Factors:** The Selectors may give weight to any one or more of the Specific Selection Factors and, if it does, to apply such weighting to one or more Athletes. No particular factor shall be weighted more or less significantly by reason only of the order in which that factor appears in this Selection Criteria.

4.6 **Extenuating Circumstances:** In any decision regarding the Selection of Athletes to the Pacific Games Team, the Selectors may, in their sole discretion, take into account any extenuating circumstances in accordance with clause 5 below.

4.7 **Selection Procedure:** After consideration of this Selection Criteria, the Selectors shall follow the procedure set out in clause 9 of the NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation.

## 5. Extenuating Circumstances

- 5.1 **Extenuating Circumstances:** In considering the Selection of Athletes in accordance with this Selection Criteria, the Selectors may, in their sole discretion, give weight to any extenuating circumstances which may include, but are not limited to, the following:
- (a) injury or illness;
  - (b) travel delays;
  - (c) equipment failure;
  - (d) bereavement or personal misfortune; and/or
  - (e) any other factors reasonably considered by the Selectors to constitute extenuating circumstances.
- 5.2 **Athlete to Advise:** Athletes unable to compete at events or other attendances required under this Selection Criteria, must advise the Convener of Selectors of the extenuating circumstances and reasons, in writing, with as much advance notice as possible and ideally seven (7) days prior to the commencement of the event, trial or other attendance. If the Convener of Selectors is not notified of any extenuating circumstances in accordance with this Selection Criteria, then the Selectors have no obligation to rely on such circumstances.
- 5.3 **Medical Certificate:** In the case of injury or illness, Athletes may be required by the Selectors to provide a medical certificate and/or to undergo an examination by a health practitioner/s nominated by the Selectors, and to provide that opinion and/or report to the Selectors. Any failure to agree to such a request may result in the Selectors being unable to consider the injury or illness as an extenuating circumstance.
- 5.4 **Case by Case:** In the case of any extenuating circumstance/s, the Selectors will make a decision on a case-by-case basis.

## 6. Appeal Procedure

- 6.1 **Selection Appeals:** An Athlete may appeal to Archery NZ against their non-Selection to the NZOC by the Selectors provided that the Athlete has returned a completed:
- (a) Athlete Application to the NZOC by the Application Date; and
  - (b) Athlete Agreement to the NZOC by the Selection Date.
- 6.2 **Procedures for Selection Appeals:** Any appeal under paragraph 6.1 must be made in accordance with the procedures set out in clause 13 of the NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation.

## 7. Inconsistencies

- 7.1 **NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation:** In the event there is any inconsistency between this Selection Criteria and the NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation, the NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation shall prevail.

7.2 **World Archery Qualification System:** If this Selection Criteria imposes a higher qualification standard or a lesser number of participants than stated by the World Archery Qualification System, this shall not be regarded as an inconsistency.

## 8. Amendments to this Selection Criteria

8.1 **Prior to Selection Date:** This Selection Criteria may be amended or supplemented from time to time by the Board, before the Selection Date.

8.2 **Notice:** The Board will give as much notice as possible of any amendment/s or supplement/s made under clause 8.1 to this Selection Criteria, to persons it considers may be affected by any such amendment/s or supplement/s.

## 9. Definitions

**Application Date** means the dates set out in clause 3.1(a), by which Athletes must submit a completed Athlete Application in accordance with clause 8.3 of the NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation.

**Archery NZ** means the Archery New Zealand Incorporated.

**Archery Event** means an event in the Games in which an Athlete competes in either a Men's or Women's Recurve 70m Qualification Round & Elimination Match Play.

**Athlete** means a person who wishes to be considered for Selection to the Pacific Games Team.

**Athlete Agreement** means the agreement that must be completed by any Athlete wishing to be considered for Selection and selection to the Pacific Games Team in accordance with clause 8.4 of the NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation.

**Athlete Application** means the form set by the NZOC that must be completed by any Athlete applying to be nominated and selected to the Pacific Games Team.

**Board** means the Board of Archery NZ as constituted under the Constitution.

**Constitution** means the Constitution of Archery NZ.

**Convener of Selectors** mean the person appointed as Convener of the Selectors for the Games set out in clause 2 of this Selection Criteria.

**Dispensation Form** means the Archery NZ Application for Dispensation Form as set out in Appendix D.

**Games** means the Pacific Games to be held in Apia, Samoa from 7<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

**Pacific Games Team** means the New Zealand Team at the Games selected in accordance with the NZOC Selection Policy for the Games.

**Intention to Apply Form** means the Archery NZ Intention to Apply Form as set out in Appendix A.

**International Event Registration Form** means the Archery NZ International Event Registration Form as set out in Appendix B.

**Key Events** mean national competition listed in clause 4.2(b).

**Nominated Athlete** means an Athlete who has been nominated to the NZOC by Archery NZ.

**Selection Criteria** means the criteria made up of the Over-Riding Selection Criteria and the Specific Selection Factors, and is also referred to as "this Criteria".

**Selection Date** means the date, as agreed by the NZOC (and includes any alternative date as agreed between NZOC and Archery NZ), by which Archery NZ must submit any Nominated Athletes to the NZOC.

**NZOC** means the New Zealand Olympic Committee Incorporated.

**NZOC Selection and Selection Regulation** means the regulation of the NZOC relation to the Selection and selection process for all Olympic and Commonwealth games, including the Games.

**Over-Riding Selection Criteria** means the criteria set out in clause 4.2.

**Selectors** means the selectors appointed by Archery NZ in accordance with clause 2 of this Selection Criteria.

**Specific Selection Factors** means the Selection factors set out in clause 4.3.
