Appendix B: Minimum Qualifying Scores and Criteria of 2024 Field Events.

MQS: based on the scores achieved by the 16th ranking archers in the last 4 World Cup Field events which should rank NZ with the top 16 Qualifiers.

The Unmarked event as a % of the Marked score.

Suggested requirements:

1: At least two made up of any combination of marked or unmarked.

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2: NZ Outdoor National Field Event and one other MAJOR Registered WA Field tournament, whether that is in NZ or Internationally.

3. While the preference is for MQS to be achieved at different events and/or different fields this will not be an overriding criterion.

The Selection Period for the 2024 World Archery Field Championships has been set as:

2nd May 2023 to 2nd May 2024. If a Tournament of relevance occurs within days of the selection period closing, at their discretion the selectors may include said Tournament.

Please review the Archery NZ International Calendar for further information for entry dates etc.

How to determine selection for over-subscribed places

The scores at the NZ National Field Championships will be used to determine the final selection.

Contingency Plan if no NZ Nationals.

It is hoped that enough time is given to organise an alternative option for selection.
