Appendix E: Minimum Qualifying Scores and Criteria of 2024 3D World Archery Events.

Minimum Qualifying Scores:

(Based on the scores achieved by the 16th ranking archers in the last 2 World Archery 3D events which should rank NZ with the top 16 Qualifiers.)

Only Open classes will be selected.

Requirements:

- 1. At least two MQS in one division.
- 2. NZ Outdoor National Field Event and one other MAJOR Registered WA Field tournament, whether that is in NZ or Internationally.
- 3. While the preference is for MQS to be achieved at different events and/or different fields this will not be an overriding criterion.
- 4. Where no animal rounds are provided at the NZ Outdoor National Field, or at a Major Registered Field Event, then applications based on other rounds will be considered. In this case, please supply all field scores from within the selection period including WA and IFAA rounds.



The Selection Period for the 2024 World Archery 3D Field Championships has been set as:

16th May 2023 to 16th May 2024. If a Tournament of relevance occurs within days of the selection period closing, at their discretion the selectors may include said Tournament.

Please review the Archery NZ International Calendar for further information for entry dates etc.

How to determine selection for over-subscribed places

The scores at the NZ National Field Championships will be used to determine the final selection.
