



CLAIMING PINS

Badges and pins can be claimed as long as you shoot in your correct age group (or a higher age group) at a registered tournament.

Please take note of which badges can be claimed where. Some can only be claimed at Major events or World Archery-registered events, while others can be claimed at Minor events.

To claim a badge, pin or award, take a copy of your signed scorecard of the event and fill out the claim form online. Each badge claimed costs \$10 to Archery NZ.

For some events, the pin registrar might be there! So come say hi.

You can claim multiple pins on each claim form, just make sure that you have each relevant scorecard attached and you have clearly stated which pin you are claiming.



Archery New Zealand Pins and Award Claims

Archery NZ has a pin and badge award system for archers who want to show their achievements and have something to strive for, and we also have World Archery awards that can be claimed.

ARCHERY NZ YOUTH AWARDS

Youth awards may be claimed by any archer in the U11, U14, U16 age groups at Major events. These are also eligible for Novice and Development level archers if the equivalent round has been shot.



Youth 1440 Merit Pins

Youth 1440 Merit pins can be claimed for the 1440 round for the following scores:
800, 900, 1000, 1100, 1150, 1200, 1250, 1300, 1350, 1400



Youth Indoor Merit Pins

These can be claimed for a 60-arrow indoor 18m or 25m round for the following scores:
300, 350, 400, 450, 500, 550, 575, 585, 595



Youth 72-Arrow Merit Pins

These can be claimed for the 72-arrow round at the Youth distances for the following scores:
500, 550, 600, 650, 675, 700



Youth Perfect Pins

The Outdoor perfects can be claimed for the following distances (metres): 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 70, 90

The Indoor perfects can be claimed for 18m & 25m.

A Perfect Round is 6 arrows in the Gold at one end (for 6-arrow ends) and 3 arrows in the 10-zone at one end (3 arrow ends).

For Clout pins see Major or Minor Claims.





ARCHERY NZ SPECIAL YOUTH AWARDS

These awards may be claimed by any archer under the age of 21



Youth Postal Round

Archery NZ runs an official youth shoot each month from February to November. Each month is a different shoot with the schedule posted on the website under Youth/Youth Monthly Rounds and Results.

Each round has an official pinscore. If you shoot this score, you are eligible to claim this award. Youth Coordinators can purchase these pins on behalf of their youth archers in bulk. These are the **ONLY** badges where you can do this.

You do not need to submit a scoresheet when claiming this award. One pinscore is required for a pin. The bars can only be claimed once.

The Round badge and ribbon can be purchased separately for you to collect all your pins on. All badges are \$10.



ARCHERY NZ PERFECT PINS

These awards may be claimed at any Major event by U18, U21, Senior and Masters 50+ and 65+ archers and all bow types.



1440 and 72-arrow Perfects

1440

- 122cm face all six arrows of one end in the gold (9 and/or 10 zone) at the two longest distances of the 1440 round.
- 80cm face all three arrows of one end in the 10 zone at the two shortest distances.

72-arrow

- All six arrows of one end in the gold (9 and/or 10 zone) for the recognised 72-arrow round distances.



Indoor Perfects

18m and 25m only. 3 arrows of one end in the ten.



Field Perfects

60cm and 80cm face only.
All three arrows of one end in the 5/6 zone.



MAJOR OR MINOR CLAIMS

These awards may be claimed at any Major OR Minor event by archers of all ages, all bow types.



Clout Perfects

All six arrows of one end in the gold (9) zone for the distances 80, 120, 140, 145, 165, 185m.

These awards may be claimed at any Major OR Minor event by archers U18, U21, Senior and Masters 50+ and 65+, all bow types.



Indoor Merit Pins

One score may be used to qualify for an indoor merit pin for the 18m and 25m WA round.

500 Recurve, Compound, Barebow, Longbow

550 Crossbow

1060 (combined 18 and 25 rounds) Other bows

1100 (combined 18 and 25 rounds) Crossbow



Imperial Perfects

All six arrows of one end in the gold (9/10 zone) at 73m and 91m (for the York and Hereford rounds).



Other Perfects

All six arrows of one end in the gold (9/10 zone) at 45 and 55m.

For the Silver Fern (35m round) all three arrows of one end in the 10 zone.



Clout Merit Star

The score to reach is 260 points for a 36-arrow Clout Round.



ARCHERY NZ MERIT STARS

These awards may be claimed at any Major event by archers U18, U21, Senior and Masters 50+ and 65+, all bow types.



1440 Stars (Recurve, Compound, Barebow)

800, 900, 950, 1050, 1150, 1250, 1350, 1400

720 Stars (Recurve, Compound, Barebow)

450, 500, 550, 600, 650, 675, 700



Crossbow 1440 Star

Crossbows only - WA 1440 star: 1000, 1100, 1200, 1300



WORLD ARCHERY CADET AND MASTERS AWARDS

These awards may be claimed at any World Archery-registered event by an U18 (Cadet) archer or a Masters (50+) archer.



Silver Target Award (Recurve Only)

These can be claimed for Recurve archers at both Indoor and Outdoor rounds. **Compound and Barebow archers see the GOLD section next page.**

Indoor: 500, 525, 550, 575 (and 585, 595 - Gold and Purple)

Outdoor: 500, 550, 600, 650 (and 675, 700 - Gold and Purple)

For gold and purple scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.

Recurve and Barebow WA Star Award (silver)

Recurve and Barebow Archers only for the 1440 Round for the following scores:

1000, 1100, 1200, 1300

For 1350 and 1400 scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.



Compound WA Star Award (silver)

Compound Archers only for the 1440 Round for the following scores:

1000, 1100, 1200, 1300

For 1350 and 1400 scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.



WORLD ARCHERY SENIOR AWARDS

These awards may be claimed at any World Archery-registered event by U21 or Senior archers.
(and Masters Compound for the Target Award).



Target Award (gold edges)



These can be claimed for Compound, Recurve and Barebow archers at both Indoor and Outdoor rounds **including U18 and Masters (50+) Compound and Barebow**.

Indoor: 500, 525, 550, 575 (and 585, 595 - Gold and Purple)

Outdoor: 500, 550, 600, 650 (and 675, 700 - Gold and Purple)

Barebow Indoor: 480, 500, 520, 540 (550, 560 - Gold and Purple)

Barebow Outdoor: 480, 500, 550, 600 (625, 640 - Gold and Purple)

For gold and purple scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.

Recurve and Barebow WA Star Award (gold)

Recurve and Barebow Archers only for the 1440 Round for the following scores:

1000, 1100, 1200, 1300

For 1350 and 1400 scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.



Compound WA Star Award (gold)

Compound Archers only for the 1440 Round for the following scores:

1000, 1100, 1200, 1300

For 1350 and 1400 scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.



ARCHERY NZ MERIT PIN SYSTEM



Archery NZ

This is the equivalent of an achievement system for most archers. These awards may be claimed at any Minor or Major event with the relevant round, and can be claimed by any age division or bow type.

Standard Merit Pins

The plain merit pin on yellow ribbon is awarded for any one score achieved at that level. The pins can be claimed in any order but if you want a way to challenge yourself, start at the beginning with the green!

Remember that Canadian 900 rounds (which are also the Archery NZ Inter-Club League rounds) are in this system, so you could register your league round as a minor or major tournament and get your members claiming these pins.

Elite Merit Pins

The elite merit pin on yellow ribbon is awarded for any one score achieved at that level.

Please note that some rounds (Ohio, St Nicholas, Short Ohio) do not have scores for the upper colour pins, so you may have to shoot another round for those pins.

WORLD ARCHERY ARROWHEAD AWARDS

These awards may be claimed at any World Archery-registered field event by U21 or Senior archers.

NOTE: The Green and Grey Arrowhead may be obtained by the U18 on their specific rounds. U21 can obtain all Arrowheads since they shoot the same distances as the Men and Women.



Arrowhead Badges

The Arrowhead Round consists of 24 or 48 targets which is two complete Field Rounds. The distances are set out in 8.1.1.9. Unit for Unmarked Course and 8.1.1.10. Unit for Marked Course as per the World Archery rulebook. The Archery NZ National field championships is USUALLY set out to this standard, but it always pays to check.

The badges can be won by Compound, Recurve or Barebow archers for the scores in the tables below (as per World Archery rules 6.3.4).

For Silver and Gold scores these are known as Performance Awards, and must be claimed through World Archery by Archery NZ as per 6.5 of the World Archery Rules.
