<u>DIVISIONS:</u>	Recurve and Compound
<u>ROUNDS:</u>	30 arrows at 18m, 80cm face, 10 zone scoring, 6 arrow ends with one 6 arrow sighting end.
<u>ELIGIBILITY:</u>	Archers must be Under 19 as at 1 January 2013 and a bona fide member of the school.

Schools who wish to have year 7 and 8 students as part of their team will require dispensation from the executive committee.

Schools must provide their own equipment, apart from targets and buttresses.

INFORMATION FOR ARCHERY ENTRIES

Grades: Teams will be seeded into grades (A grade, B grade etc.) by a classification shoot which will be held on the 27 February 2013 at Auckland Archery Club and Mt Green Archery Club.

Schools may use the grading round as a trial with final team player names to be submitted by 1 March. School teams will be seeded based on their top four individual scores for the A team, next four for the B team etc. Organisers will endeavor to accommodate all entrants, though a limit of teams per school may be imposed in the event that venues are filled.

Note: All participants must have been educated in range safety as part of an archery course.

Draws/Times: Draw information will be circulated once draws have been finalised. These may change at any time throughout the season. Please check the College Sport website regularly (www.asbcollegesport.co.nz).

Competitions will be held **Wednesday nights** at Auckland Archery Club, One Tree Hill Domain and Mt Green Archery Club, Mt Albert, **with time slots between 4:15pm and 6:15pm.**

Team Management: All teams must have a school-approved adult in charge of their students at the venue for the entirety of the match where a school is competing. If there is no supervision, a school will be deemed to have lost by default, and they shall not participate

Range Management: The hosting club will provide a range captain to control the range for each competition and to judge arrow scores.
