CADET RECURVE ARCHERS: the correct World Archery ranking and match play event is the 60m 72 arrow round. Cadet Recurve archers entering the target event will shoot the 60m round as part of their target event, and can claim Archery NZ and World Records in this division. These archers have the option to specify a preference to shoot the 60m match play event if it is offered, or shoot the 60m ranking round and join the 70m match play (being ranked after the archers who shot the 70m 72 arrow round) or abandon the 60m round and shoot the 70m ranking round and match play.

The 60m match play event will only run if there are four or more archers per division who want to shoot this event. If there are insufficient numbers for the event to proceed, then these archers will join the 70m match play event, and rank underneath all those archers who shot the 70m ranking round.

Cadet archers may elect to shoot the 70m ranking round as an alternative to the 60m round, to gain a higher ranking in the 70m match play event. Such archers are effectively abandoning their normal class, and therefore will not be eligible for medals in the target event, but will be eligible for medals in the match play event.

DRESS CODE:

The Archery New Zealand Dress Code applies to this tournament. Athletes shall be neatly and cleanly dressed in sporting attire. Such attire may be White, current Club, Regional Squad or National Uniform, or sponsorship merchandise. Advertising must adhere to the World Archery advertising eligibility rules (WA 2.2.6 and 2.2.7). These rules do not apply to the Field rounds to be shot at this tournament.

TOURNAMENT VENUES:

- Field rounds will be held at the Lake View Archery Club. They are located at 265 Horahora Road, Tirau. This is approximately ten minutes' drive north of the Tirau township, on SH 1.
- Clout and Target rounds will be held at Puarenga Park, off Te Ngae Road in Rotorua. This is the big cricket / soccer field immediately next to the Rotorua Archery Club range. Parking will be either at the Whakarewarewa Rugby Club rooms at the Te Ngae / Sala Street traffic lights, or along the fence line opposite the BMX club
